


To Access the Course:

The following is a list of instructions on how to register and access the online modules for a course on www.learning.gaa.ie: It is recommended that the course is completed on a desktop or laptop.





1. Register on GAA E-Learning Portal by clicking on 'Register' in the top right hand corner of www.learning.gaa.ie
2. Fill in details. *NB Choose Registration Type 'Without GAA Membership Number' unless you have your GAA Club Membership ID to hand.*
3. A confirmation email will be sent to the email address you entered during registration, where you must click on the relevant link. *(NB Some confirmation emails are arriving in Spam/Junk Folders)*

- When you are redirected back into the site, the user will be asked to accept a Site Policy Agreement and then complete your 'Profile' by filling in the mandatory fields.

To Access the Course

- Login to www.learning.gaa.ie using the username (email address) and password used during registration
- Click on the 'E-Learning' black button on the right, as shown below:



- In Course categories click on the [Player Section](#) and select [“GAA Senior Inter-County Player Anti-Doping 2017”](#)
- Click the Enter Icon to begin the course.
- If you are required to attempt the course on further occasions please tick Start a new attempt at step 4 when you are re-entering the course.
