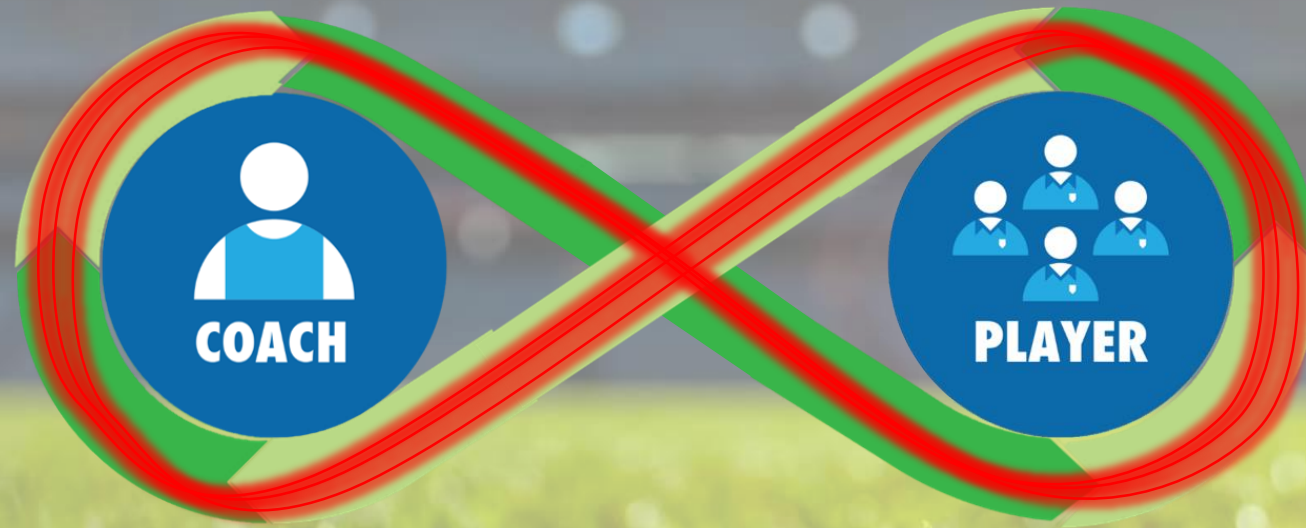

Starting Point - 2015

- Pilot Year
- 10 Super Games Centres
- 430 Participants
- 24 Weeks

Club Super Games 2017 Participation Figures

- 540 Super Games Blitzes organised at Club level
- 685 Clubs participated in Super Games Blitzes
- 662 Clubs participated in 3+ Super Games Blitzes
- 20,091 boys played an average of 5 Super Games Blitzes each at Club level

Post Primary School Super Games 2017 Participation Figures

- 833 Super Games Blitzes organised in Post Primary Schools
- 328 Schools participated in Super Games Blitzes
- 304 Schools participated in 3+ Super Games Blitzes
- 14,884 boys and 1,751 girls (mixed schools) played an average of 4 Super Games Blitzes each at Post Primary School level

Tackling Dropout at Post Primary Level

- 328 Schools participating in Super Games Blitzes.
- Traditionally only 24 players making school teams in the Junior Cycle = 7,872 players.
- Super Games Centres allows for an additional 7,012 players to participate – almost 100% increase.
