#### 1. The ABC of Report Writing

While the practical elements of refereeing like fitness, rules examination and advisor reports are vitally important to the development of the referee it is very fair to say that the job is not complete until the Referee's Report has been completed and submitted to the secretary of the committee-in-charge.

In saying that it is also recognised that the completion of the report can be a considerable challenge to the referee and **The ABC of Report Writing** will, hopefully, assist the referee in completing his report in an **A**ccurate, **B**rief and **C**lear fashion.

In writing the report it is very important that the referee is **CLEAR**.

Concise – give sufficient detail of infraction, using the language of the rule, do not overelaborate or exaggerate.

Legible – make sure your report can be easily read.

Efficient – where disciplinary issues are involved, please aim to have your report submitted by photo or email to the secretary of the Committee-in-Charge within 24 hours of the game. In any event, please ensure that it is posted to the secretary within three days of the game.

Accurate – exact details all through the report using the language of the rules.

Relevant – stick to the facts.

The Referee's report should be signed in Irish, and the teams involved


