# COVID SUPERVISOR ROLE OVERVIEW

#### **BEFORE YOU TRAIN**

- All Covid Supervisors must complete the Gaelic Games Return to training module on GAA eLearning website. Full details in <u>https://courses.gaa.ie/Covid19ClubEd</u>
- All Covid Supervisors must complete the health questionnaire once before returning to training. It can be accessed here - <u>https://returntoplay.gaa.ie/</u>
- Please note: The health declaration must be completed before every training session reconfirming that a participants health status has not changed. It can be accessed by logging into the same link as the health questionnaire and simply clicking "Reconfirm this"

#### HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE AND DECLARATION

- ✓ The Health Questionnaire is now available at <u>https://returntoplay.gaa.ie</u>
- A hard copy version is also available.
- Health Questionnaire must be completed by each participant before returning to Club activity.
- Each participant must also declare their Health Status hasn't changed prior to each time they participate.
- ✓ Covid Supervisors monitor the completion of the Health Questionnaire and Health Declaration.
- The presence of symptoms, or temperature (over 37.5°C) percludes attendance at training/games.

### **RECORD ATTENDANCE AT TRAINING / GAMES**

- ✓ The Covid Supervisor will maintain a record of attendance at each training session/game.
- This is important in the event that contact tracing or other intervention is required.

### CLEANING / SANITISING OF FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

- At the end of each training session, the Covid Supervisor should disinfect touch point areas such as door handles and playing equipment.
- ✓ Use disinfectant spray or wipes and ensure they are listed as killing 99% of bacteria.
