The Mark – options when awarded

- Take a free-kick

WHAT IS A CLEAN CATCH?

Definition of Catch:

To gain control of the ball with the hand(s) in a way which prevents it falling to the ground.

FAQs

- How does the Referee By blowing the whistle. award a "Mark"?
- To be awarded a Mark does the catch have to be from a player's own kick-out?

No, no matter who catches the kick-out outside the 45m line a Mark shall be awarded.

How does the player "signify to the Referee" that he is availing of the free kick?

He obviously stops playing.

How long has the player awarded the Mark to take the free kick?

He shall not delay longer than 5 seconds.



FAQs

- If the player awarded The Mark shall what is the penalty?
- How far do players free kick?
- What happens if from player opposing team blocks, block attempts to within 13m or interferes with a player who has chosen to take a free kick?

the Mark delays for cancelled and a throw more than 5 seconds - in between a player side from each awarded.

have to be from the All players must be 13m from the free kick.

> A Free kick 13m more advantageous shall be awarded.

mate plays the ball to the opposition. within 13m of the free kick awarded for the Mark?

What happens if a team A Free kick is awarded

If the player awarded the Mark is injured in the process what is the award?

Any team mate may take the free kick from the hands, but he may not score directly from the kick.

What is the award if a player, who is taking the free kick following an injury to his team mate, scores directly?

The free kick is cancelled and a throwin ball awarded.

When the awarded the Mark he takes four steps or decides to play on, once he plays the ball when may he be tackled?

player He may be tackled after in any way.

What is the penalty if a player who has chosen to play on is illegally challenged?

A Free kick shall be awarded at the point at which the illegal challenge is made.
