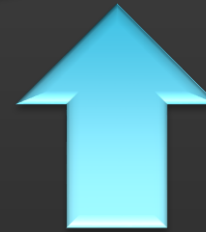
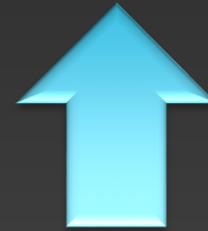
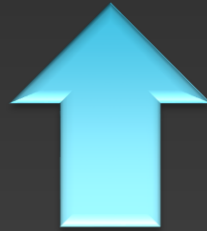


The Self we present to the world
