• 'It took more than five or six years before we could GET everyone ON BOARD.

A lot of coaches (and clubs) had a different focus: the only thing they were caring about was **winning the game. And nothing else. Focus on performance!**

'But that was absolutely wrong for the development of (all) the players.
 Totally wrong.



• 'It wasn't easy. In the beginning it was terrible. They needed a coaching SWITCH:

<u>stop</u> thinking about **your team** and the results

start thinking about THE INDIVIDUAL PLAYER!

 But step by step they began to see the process. They joined "our boat" because they saw that it worked: It made players better.





The **development** of a player can be devided in **different stages**, within every stage we have **different emphasis** on the development of technical, tactical, physical and mental skills **according to the age and level**.


We bind all different stages into a developing line: learning plan
















- Create an environment that makes talent flourish!



The player is the norm... Efficiency in coaching/learning

- "Too many coaches think that football performance is all about X's and O's, but it's much more than that."
- Many coaches think that coaching is an X's and O's business, but in reality, it is a relationship business.
 The secret to great coaching (and a successful performance) isn't simply technique, or tactics, or fitness.



• Without relationship , there is no learning (development) possible...

Visible learning (John Hattie, 2009)

...the greatest effects on student LEARNing occur when the TEACHers become **LEARNers** of their own TEACHing and...



...when students become their own TEACHers.

John Hattie – Visible Learning (2009, p. 22)

How do you measure the success of your sessions?

A coach needs to see learning through the eyes of the player...

...so players can see themselves as their own coach.

Visible Teaching - Visible Learning by John Hattie

TIRE

How do you measure the IMPACT of your sessions?

A coach needs to see learning through the eyes of the player...

So players can see themselves as their own coach/teacher



Evidence shows that the greatest effects on student learning come when not only the students become their own teachers (through self-monitoring, and self-assessment), but the teachers become learners of their own teaching.

In successful learning environments, both the teaching and learning are visible.
